I tried the installation process. I got a message that a previous version of the program was already installed. I didn't get the "first time" message. The error message is "cannot create installer file". I would like to know if you can post your log file as a.txt file on the support site, that way I can look it over. I'm not sure what you mean by log file? I'm using the most recent version of the installer. The installer is working fine. The only problem is that the installer doesn't allow me to install the latest version of Cubase.
